We also thank God for His provision of Kevin teBrake, Hons. B. Comm, MDiv, for the new role of Director of Planned Gifts and Investments. It is unusual to find a person with such dedication to Christian education who has been a professional accountant and a lead pastor! That is exactly the combination of skills and experiences that the Christian School Foundation was hoping to find! Kevin is quickly proving to be very resourceful and adaptable – just the kinds of characteristics we need on a team like ours!

Times of transitions often do involve some sense of loss, and this one has been no exception. But we can see clearly that God has brought Kevin to our team “for such a time as this” and we are excited to see how God will use His Foundation to bless our schools and donors!



Belonging Bursary

When you were in school, did you ever experience conflict? Did you have to “just figure things out on your own”?

At Kingston Christian School we wanted to do better than that. Our students are a standard assortment of girls and boys. That means we have some students who live on the autism spectrum, some students who need space to step out of situations in order to calm down, and our whole group of students who are learning essential social skills as they learn to read and write.

When you supported the Belonging Bursary, you helped us build a Community of Belonging in three different ways.

With our first Belonging Bursary you helped Miriam S., who is on the autism spectrum, receive one-on-one support in Grade 1. She is now going into Grade 3 and is a much more interdependent learner because she has developed skills that mean she now only requires indirect support. You’ve made an important difference for her that will last a lifetime!



Our second Belonging Bursary focused on what we had noticed over the course of a school year: lots of students would perform better if they had a chance to “step back” and go to a calming place for a time. The Zones Room is not intended to be for any particular students. It is for any boy or girl who is facing special stressors in their lives – health issues, family conflict, parental divorce, conflict with peers, or family financial stress. Having access to this safe space for a time means students can return to a focus on their studies with greater success. You made this possible.

Last year, we received Belonging Bursary support to hire a Child and Youth Worker who leads targeted

interventions with individual students and groups of students who need support as they face hardships, conflicts, or tricky social situations. The result? Absenteeism is down, academics have improved, and students have positive conflict resolution skills they are using to build a community where everyone belongs and feel safe. Because we are a Christian school these tools reinforce our student’s understanding of their identity in Christ: each one is His beloved Child.

You have made Kingston Christian School a better school and a better Christian school, and we can’t adequately express our gratitude for the Christian School Foundation donors who support the Belonging Bursary. You are having a profound, life-long impact on our students.

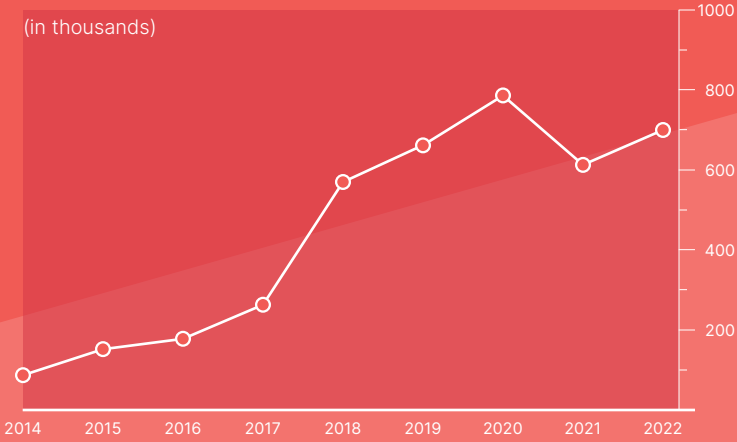
Tuition Assistance

Working Together for the Long Term

One of the advantages of having your school be a member of the Christian School Foundation is the opportunity to engage with professional fund managers who are licensed and experienced in the area of long-term fund investment. In our case that means having two fund managers – Christian Stewardship Services (CSS) and Jarislowsky-Fraser who are charged with the stewardship of our longer-term gifts. The Foundation doesn't act as your school's investment advisor, but rather is a means through which we can work coop-

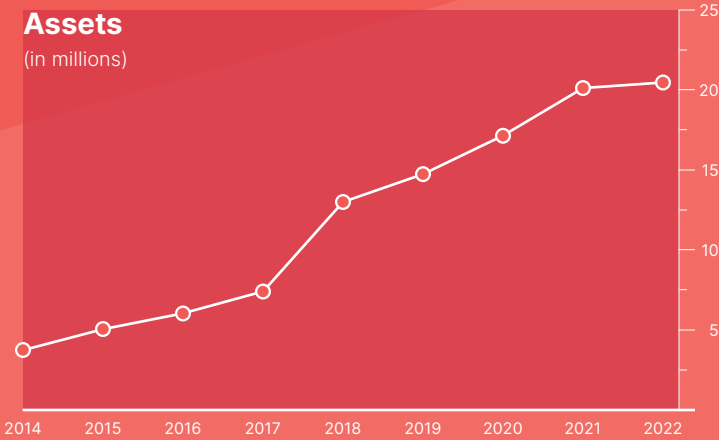
eratively as a group of 90 schools to gain access to opportunities that wouldn't otherwise be available to each of us individually.

It is important to recognize that our focus is and remains on longer-term funds. When the markets see some fluctuations – as has been the case in this past year – we keep our eyes on the longer term and encourage patience because historically these things settle into more stable growth patterns that can bless your school over time.

(in millions)

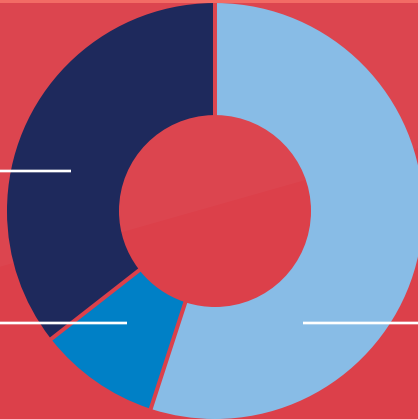


Distributions to Member Schools
